I can't imagine walking down the hall to the copy machine and not passing by his open door and seeing his office in characteristic disarray and, reared back in a chair, marking up some student paper in copious marginalia written in green felt pen, Jim, doing what he did for all of us, which was to make us better people, better writers, better community members, even if we were the nocomma-using-est layabouts he had ever encountered.


